..... The Regina-based president of Muslims for Peace & Justice (MPJ), Riazuddin Ahmed, released a statement in light of the events.

"We strongly and unequivocally condemn the terror attacks that took place today in London," he said. "Such despicable acts of cruelty and destruction have no place in Islam. We pray for the victims and their families, and hope that the perpetrators are swiftly brought to justice."

Premier Lorne Calvert extended his sympathies to Prime Minister Tony Blair and has ordered flags lowered to half-mast at provincial and federal government buildings.

The City of Saskatoon has also lowered flags at city facilities in honour of the victims.
